

# Guidelines for In-Person Worship

We encourage anyone in at-risk categories to continue to worship with us online. However, you must decide what level of risk you are willing to take. Our entire service will be streamed live on YouTube and Facebook. Service will begin at 10:45am on Sundays and will remain on our YouTube channel and Facebook page for viewing at a later time.

## Entering and Exiting the building:

- Wear a mask at all times.
- Do not arrive more than fifteen (15) minutes before the start of the worship service.
- Those attending worship in the sanctuary must enter and exit through the John West Rd doors.
- Your temperature will be checked before entering the building and you may be asked to not come in the building.
- Do not gather in the narthex or sanctuary before or after service. These types of gathering will make it difficult for those entering and exiting the building to maintain proper social distancing.
- If you want to talk with your friends, you must do so outside while maintaining adequate social distancing.
- Hand sanitizer will be available as you enter and exit the building.

## While you are in the building:

- There will be no Sunday School or access to any part of the building other than the sanctuary.
- There will be no coffee or donuts.
- Restrooms will be open but are not to be used unless absolutely necessary. If you must:
  - Use sanitizing wipes provided in the bathroom.
  - User hand sanitizer upon exiting the bathroom.
- Do not gather with friends while in the building.
- Always use adequate social distancing while on the Owenwood property.

## Worship Service:

- Worship will be different and feel strange.
- Masks will be required, even for congregational singing, which will be limited.
- Do not shake hands or hug one another.
- Offering plates will not be passed, but they will be at the doors as you leave.
- Sit only with people from your own household.
- In the sanctuary, you may sit where there are chairs set out. Please ask a Deacon to provide additional chairs if they are needed for your family household. Children and youth must sit with their parents/guardians.
- You most likely will not be able to sit in your usual spot.
- Maintain social distancing at all times during worship.
- Printed bulletins will not be available. All service announcements, scripture and songs will be projected.
